**UNSETTLED WAR DEBT**

Washington, Oct. 23.—The World War Foreign Debt Commission met recently to prepare its report to Congress. This will show that the British and Cuban debts having been settled and an agreement made for submission to Congress, covering the relative small indebtedness of Finland, the commission still has to deal with debts of foreign governments to the United States amounting to \$1,088,467,478.15 has accrued, making a total of \$7,088,574,905.48.
