

New York, July 28. — Gas escaping through the cracks of her carefully stuffed bedroom door led neighbors to the discovery that Mrs. Mary Hummer, thirty-two years old, of 505 West 134th street, had killed herself and one of her twin babies which lay in her arms. The second child, two-months-old Doris, was hurried to Harlem Hospital, where it was said that she was in a critical condition.
