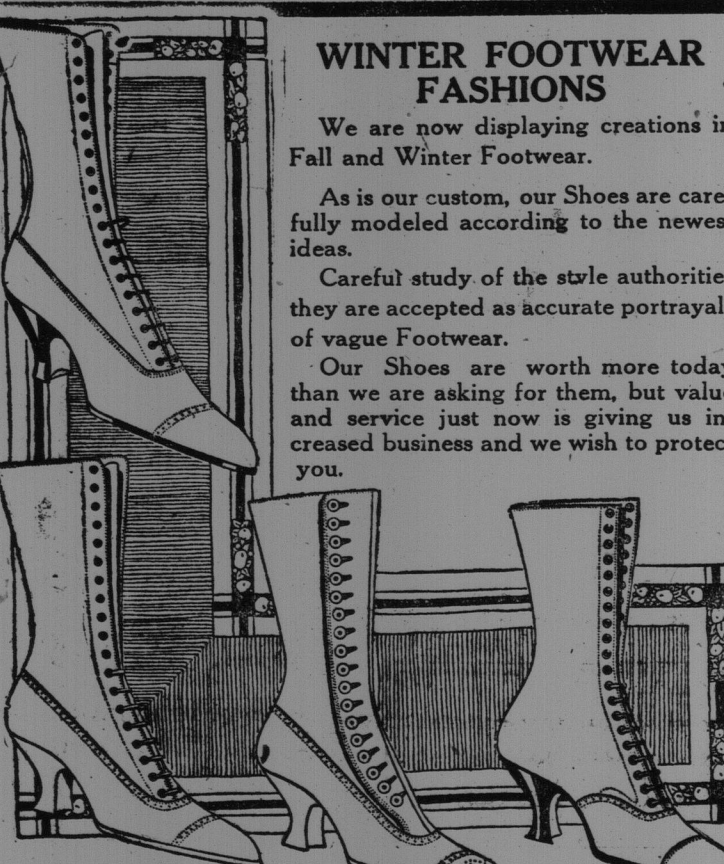

NEW TRAINING FOR WOMEN

It seems probable that women will soon be employed in this country as engine cleaners and wipers. In both England and France during the war it was a common sight to see women in overalls, greasy and grimy, taking the place of men around the huge locomotives, and now the New York Central Railroad has intimated that the experiment will be tried out over here. The plans for the new \$200,000 round house at Watertown include a room most modern in its equipment and designed especially for women. There is no effort made to conceal the fact that it was planned for women, and that it is considered not at all unlikely, in view of present labor difficulties, that women will shortly appear in the yards, the repair shop and the adjoining quarters which have been provided.
