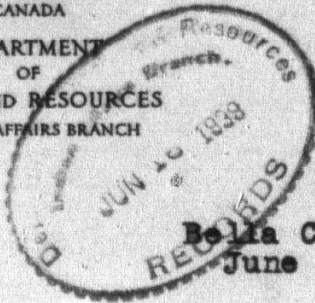

Dear Sir:-

I am enclosing herewith the amended statutory declaration regarding Katit Indian Reserve license renewal.

The reason why the Pacific Mills Ltd. has not begun logging operations on this Reserve is because the market conditions in the pulp and paper industry caused them to curtail mill operation. This consequently left them with a supply of logs on hand.

They applied for a three-year extension and it was granted by the Department. Pacific Mills agreed to construct seven houses and to furnish material for the eighth house for the Indians of the Katit Reserve. The cost of these houses is not to exceed seven thousand dollars, which will be a charge against subsequent stumpage dues for timber taken off the Katit Reserve.
