SERVICE OF THE CHEEKERS

MONDAY, 10 O'Clock, A. M. June 21st, 1847.

The Introductory Sermon was preached by the Rev. Charles Randall, from Isaiah 52: 1., after which a collection was taken in aid of Home Missions, in addition to the collections taken on the preceding day.

The Association having been called to order, Rev. John Pryor was appointed Moderator, Rev. Wm. Chipman, Clerk, and bro. Isnac Chipman, Assistant Clerk.

Revs. John Pryor, John Chase, and R. B. Dickie, were chosen to read the Letters from the Churches, and Revs. Charles Randall, N. Vidito, and James Parker, to examine the same previously.
