

At the annual meeting held at Windsor, on Wednesday, 28th June, 1865, the following resolution was proposed by A. M. Uniacke, Esq., D.C.L., and seconded by Col. Poyntz, and passed :

*Resolved*, That any member of this society whose annual subscription shall remain and be unpaid for three years, shall cease to be a member of this society, and can only be admitted as a new member by being proposed and seconded and duly elected pursuant to the bye-laws.

At the annual meeting held at Windsor, on Wednesday, 23rd June, 1869, the following resolution was proposed by A. M. Uniacke, D.C.L., seconded by Dr. Almon, and passed :—

“That the Board of Governors be requested to furnish, previous to the annual general meeting of the Associated Alumni in each year, for their information, a copy of the Treasurer's account.”

At the same meeting, Rev. Charles Bowman moved the following resolution, which was seconded by Frederick Allison, and passed :

“That all officers of the Associated Alumni shall have been members of the Association, for at least one year previous to their appointment.”
