Welding Lord Dufferin Together. What is said to be the largest welding a new stern on the freighter Lord Dufferin, sixty feet of the hull having been cut off when she was in collision with the Aquitania in the harbor nearly a month ago, was begun a few days ago at the Robins Dry Doch, Brooklyn. Among the spectators who took a keen interest in the way the workmen handled the oxy-acetylemetorches was a group of Japanese representing the leading shipbuilders and engineering experts of Japan.

The harbor strike prevented her being raised until a few days ago, when she was towed to the dry dock in Brooklyn.
