Cocoa Date Roly-Poly
2 cups flour
2 teaspoons baking powder
1 cup milk
1/2 teaspoon vanilla
2 tablespoons butter
1/2 teaspoon salt
6 Coconuts

Method—Mix flour, salt, baking powder and Coconuts. Cut in the butter, and add milk slowly, mixing thoroughly. Turn on floured board, roll 1/4 inch thick. Spread with date filling. Roll. Steam 25 minutes, being careful not to raise cover during steaming. Serve with hard sauce.

DEATH CAUSED BY STARVATION
Celebrated Meteorologist, Dr. Margolis, Perishes from Lack of Food.

Vienna, Oct. 27.—Professor Exner has notified the Vienna Neue Presse that the celebrated Austrian meteorologist, Dr. Margolis, died from starvation. Margolis, who was 69 years old, was retired on a pension of 120 crowns monthly, or the equivalent of one dollar, and stubbornly refused offers of help. The tragic story shows the desperate straits of a numerous class of old Austrian pensioners who, owing to the great depreciation of Austrian money, are condemned to perish from hunger.

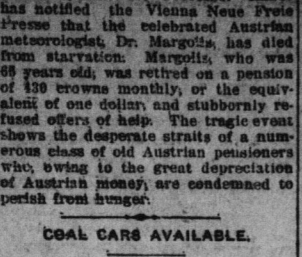
