MORE THAN 270 MILLIONS ASKED IN NEW U. S. ARMY BILL

Measure Reported by House Committee With Provisions Which Would Necessitate a Reduction of Army to 115,000 Men and 11,000 Officers.

Washington, March 15.—With provisions which would necessitate a reduction of the regular army to 115,000 enlisted men and 11,000 officers, the army appropriation bill, carrying \$270,000,000, was reported today by the House Appropriations Committee.

The amount carried in the bill for seacoast fortifications, the committee reported, would not provide for any new projects, but would go entirely for the maintenance of existing fortifications and for continuing the construction of a limited number of seacoast guns.

The total recommended for river and harbor improvements, about \$16,000,000 less than the amount sought by the chief of engineers, is carried as a lump sum, and projects on which work would be continued are not specified.

RETAIN TERROR AS WEAPON OF BOLSHEVISTS

Stand Ready to Use It Again Against Any Conspiracy to Overthrow Soviet

Berlin, March 14.—Mussolini's advice says that Premier Lenin in addressing the metal workers convention declared the Bolsheviks had by no means discarded terror as their weapon.

Previous to Lenin's announcement of his intention to go to Geneva and measure swords with Mr. Lloyd George in economic and political controversy, the Bolshevik newspapers had been making much of an alleged discovery that Italian Fascists were plotting to kidnap the entire Soviet delegation in order to bring pressure through the hostages to overthrow the Soviet regime.

The experiment, however, was tried before, but the previous watch-dog of the Treasury, Dr. Oari, quit the job in disgust after a few months during which he found his proposals all deliberately sabotaged by one minister or another.

The Council of State alone has made a serious effort to cut down the swollen bureaucracy. A hundred official heads have been lopped off and a few cuts made in official expenditures.

The conditions proposed by the People's party for acceptance of the taxation compromise are such a matter of course for a Government pledged to an economical administration of the country that an outsider might wonder why it is even discussed as an ultimatum to the Government.

It is reported here that the town of Mayen, fifteen miles west of Coblenz, in the American sector, will now receive a garrison of 600 French troops.
