Man Who Revolutionized Shoe Trade With His Sewing Machine.

REMARKABLE CAREER.

Twice Married and as Many Times Divorced—Presented His Second Wife With \$100,000 When She Married Again—Harvard Likely to Get Millions in His Will.

Newport, R. I., Oct. 20.—Gordon McKay, whose invention of the shoe sewing machine revolutionized the shoe industry of the world, died at his residence here at 11.35 this morning of cancer of the intestines with which he had suffered for nearly two years.

He was thoroughly conversant with the end and purpose of his machine, and he had spent his life in perfecting it.

His next of kin who were with him when he died were Mrs. Gordon Decker and her daughter, Miss Dexter, of Chicago, who will receive a large bequest under his will.

It is understood that Harvard College will receive a bequest of between \$3,000,000 and \$4,000,000, which will go to the Lawrence Scientific School.
