ST. JOHN OFFICIALS ARE REAPPOINTED

Thos. A. Linton Continues as Liquor License Commissioner

Mrs. R. C. Skinner Succeeds Herself as School Trustee Two Appointments to Normal School Staff—Big Tract of Land Bought from N. B. Railway Company for Settlers—Rain Causes Horse Races to Be Postponed—Death of Dr. Coburn—Other News.

(Special to The Telegraph.) Fredericton, N. B., July 25.—At the government meeting this evening, an order-in-council was passed bringing the town of St. George under the schools act. Edward McGrattan, J. Sutton Clarke, James O'Brien and Mrs. Grace J. Watt were appointed school trustees. Mr. McGrattan will be the chairman of the board. St. Andrews was made a separate health district, and G. King Greenlaw was appointed chairman of the board of health. There was some discussion in regard to the governor-general's visit to the province, and members of the executive expected to meet his excellency at St. John and accompany him to Fredericton. Mrs. R. C. Skinner was appointed school trustee for St. John, and Thomas Linton was reappointed liquor license commissioner.

Acting under authority of legislation passed last session, a survey was ordered on ten acre lots for miners at Minto, Sunbury county. The premier submitted a report on the recent hearing at Ottawa before the Deputy Minister of Railways Butler on the application of the Atlantic Quebec & Western Railway for authority to build a line across the northern part of the province. The contentions of the province were upheld. It was ordered that a survey be made of twenty-five acre lots in Madawaska county to be used for settlement purposes. The land was recently inspected by Abram Alward, of the agricultural department, who reported it well adapted for agriculture. It was decided to procure 1,000 copies of a new hand book of the province, lately prepared by Dr. Hannay. It is a volume of 160 pages, profusely illustrated, and containing much valuable information, and it was also decided to purchase 4,000 copies of the new colored map of the province, lately prepared by Colonel LaSalle.

Normal School Appointments. The board of education met this morning and appointed Miss Margaret Lynde of Hopewell Cape, Albert county, to the vacant position of instructor of elocution and physical culture on the staff of the Provincial Normal School, Clarendon, by the resignation of Miss Alice Clarke. The salary attached to the position is \$800 per year, and she will enter upon her duties at the opening of the school in September. The new appointee completed a course at the normal school here a few years ago and afterwards attended Emerson College of Oratory. Subsequently she was on the staff of Acadia Seminary, Sherbrooke, and Miss Lynde, of Hopewell Cape, is her brother. Miss Edna Golding, daughter of City Treasurer Golding, was appointed teacher of the primary department of the model school, the position made vacant by the resignation of Miss Nicholson. She has

ONTARIO SKIRM CREATES HAVOC

Western Section Swept by Almost a Hurricane and Heavy Rain

MUCH FRUIT RUINED Trees and Telephone Poles Levelled—Campers on Lake Shore Had Tents Blown to Sea—Many Buildings Damaged by Lightning or Destroyed.

(Special to The Telegraph.) Toronto, July 25.—Western Ontario was visited by a severe storm last night. At Middlemarch, near St. Thomas, there was almost a hurricane. A big barn owned by Barnes Bros., proprietors of the Iroquois Hotel, St. Thomas, was blown over and thirty-five loads of hay spoiled, loss \$2,000. The gable of the Methodist church was blown off and the driving sheds damaged. Geo. Statton's barn was damaged, and trees and fences blown over. At Hill Crest a barn was burned. At Beausville, Price Conkles fine barn, filled with new hay, was struck by lightning and burned. At Pickering a terrible thunderstorm levelled the trees and telegraph poles. The village school was struck by lightning and a hole two feet square burned in the roof. The fire was extinguished by the villagers. Wire connection and electric lighting was cut off for several hours. In Niagara district trees were blown down and much fruit destroyed. Campers on the lake shores had their tents blown out to sea and rain fell in torrents.

STEAMER SENLAC SUCCESSFULLY FLOATED

Will Be Placed on Marine Railway at Halifax—S. S. Bridgewater, Also, Raised.

(Special to The Telegraph.) Halifax, N. S., July 25.—The steamer Senlac, which was so damaged by collision with the Rosford in Halifax harbor some weeks ago that she had to be beached, was successfully floated this afternoon. The Senlac was towed across the harbor to the Intercolonial piers awaiting a chance to get on the marine railway which is full at present. A despatch from Port Dufferin says the steamer Bridgewater, which went ashore near there some time ago, has been floated and towed into Port Dufferin. The placing of new steamers on the Glasgow and Montreal routes, which the S. S. Corrib, the Grampian, the Numidian and Mongolian, at present employed in this service. These vessels will be dispatched as follows: The steamer Corrib and Sicilian will run to Philadelphia; the S. S. Numidian to Boston, and the S. S. Mongolian will take her place on the Havre route to Montreal.

THE BRITISH PRESS OF WELL KNOWN PARTY COMING HERE

Eleven Editors Due at Quebec This Week to Tour All of Canada.

Ottawa, July 25.—(Special)—W. J. White of the immigration department left today for Quebec to meet eleven British newspaper editors who are going to make a tour of the Maritime provinces tomorrow by the Allan line. After spending some time in Ontario they go to the west, and upon their return will proceed to the maritime provinces. San Francisco, July 25.—A segregation of the returns of the work on rescue shows that of the 245 lives on the ill-fated Columbia 122 have been saved, while five bodies have been recovered and eight-eight are reported lost. Of the entire number of the lost, thirty-one were men, forty-nine women, and five children. Of the 191 passengers, 141 have been saved; sixty-seven of these have been taken to Astoria, eight have arrived here, and the remainder are at Eureka or on their way to this city. Of the ninety-three men, fifty were saved and of the ninety-nine women, forty-two were saved. Two of the seven children survived and of the fifty-four members of the crew, thirty-eight are alive.

CHATHAM BOYS ARRESTED, CHARGED WITH STEALING

Chatham, N. B., July 25.—Herbert Mayo, aged 17, an ex-former school boy, and Tom Cripps, another youth, were arrested yesterday on a charge of stealing over \$100 from Capt. Gallant, of the schooner White Bird, now in port from P. E. Island. Some boys were playing around the wharf and told Capt. Gallant when he discovered his loss that they had seen Mayo go on board that evening. Young Mayo came to the schooner and said to Capt. Gallant that he heard he accused him of taking the money. "Yes," replied the captain, "I do, and I have sent for the police to arrest you." At that Mayo wilted and said he would return the money. Going to a spot beneath Snowball's warehouse he returned and handed the captain \$54 and said that was all that was in the purse and he had thrown the pocketbook over the wharf. The captain is certain he had more than \$100 in the book. Later in the evening Tom Cripps gave the captain \$4, which he said Mayo had given him, and Cripps was also locked up. Mayo has been concerned in several escapades.

ALLAN SERVICE TO BE IMPROVED

Two Monster Vessels Ordered Which Will Far Surpass Their Best

NEW ONES READY The Grampian Launched Thursday, and the Hesperian, in December—The Corsican at Montreal on Her First Trip—Older Vessels to Go on Other Routes.

(Special to The Telegraph.) Montreal, July 25.—The management of the Allan Steamship Company has decided on extensive improvements to their entire service. The officials have been considering this important work and this week they arrived at a decision as to the desirability of making a rearrangement, not only to the St. Lawrence service, but on every line operated by the Allan Company. The Liverpool service to the St. Lawrence has already received the new R. M. S. Cordcan, now in port on her initial visit to this county, which with the steamer Virginia, Victorian and Tunisian will make up the fleet for the next two years. Two Monster Vessels. The Allan will place an order shortly for two new and monster vessels surpassing, it is said, in size and speed any of their boats now crossing the Atlantic. These two vessels, together with the Liverpool service during the season of 1909. The service between Glasgow and Montreal is to be improved by the addition of two new steamers—the Grampian, by far the finest vessel in England, and the Hesperian, to be launched in December next, and to be ready for service at the opening of navigation next season. The S. S. Cordcan, Victorian, Numidian and Mongolian, at present employed in this service. These vessels will be dispatched as follows: The steamer Corrib and Sicilian will run to Philadelphia; the S. S. Numidian to Boston, and the S. S. SUDDEN DEATH OF WELL KNOWN SUSSEX MAN

John H. Mace Stricken With Paralysis While at Smith's Creek Thursday, and Expired Soon After.

(Special to The Telegraph.) Sussex, N. B., July 25.—John H. Mace, a resident of Maple Avenue, who is widely known and highly respected, died very suddenly this evening at 7 o'clock at the home of George Manning, Smith Creek. Mr. Mace accompanied by Mr. Patterson, drove to Smith Creek at noon today to survey some land property. On arrival Mr. Mace complained of being ill, and immediately he was stricken with paralysis and remained in an unconscious state until death. Deceased was 65 years of age, and had followed milling the greater part of his life, until a few years ago when he retired. He was for many years councilor for the town of Havelock, also magistrate and assessor for the town of Sussex. A wife, son, and daughter survive. Mr. Mace was a devoted Christian, and his death was a great loss to his family and the community.

WARNER DENIES KILLING GIRL

In His Ante-mortem He Declares He Didn't Shoot Miss Norling, But He Did Wilson.

New York, July 25.—Frank H. Warner, who on last Tuesday shot and killed Miss Esther Norling, a bookkeeper, and then eluded the police for three hours, only to reappear again and shoot down his friend John C. Wilson, who died from his wounds, last night, made an ante-mortem statement today in which he denied all knowledge of the shooting of Miss Norling, but admitted the shooting of Wilson. Warner had so far recovered today from his injuries received in his efforts to escape from a truckman, who struck him with a cotton book, that the police decided to take his statement as to his motives for the killing. Warner's statement was taken at Bellevue Hospital. He told a representative of the district attorney's office and the police that he knew nothing about the shooting of Miss Norling nor any of the subsequent events of the supreme court. Mr. Fleming said he shot Wilson and that Wilson was responsible for his failure two years ago to convict McMullin, a wife and several children.

HON. W. J. BOWSER, B. C. ATTORNEY GENERAL

MONCTON NOTES AGAINST GRANT

Proposal to Let Exhibition Association Have \$10,000 Turned Down

WILL NOT STOP IT Director States Fair Will Be Held Next Year Just the Same—C. H. Beardsley of Berwick, N. S., Looking for Runaway Boy—Other News of the Railway Town.

(Special to The Telegraph.) Moncton, N. B., July 25.—By a majority of 43 votes today the electors defeated the proposed city grant of \$10,000 to the Moncton Association for an exhibition in 1908. The exhibition association offered for the grant, but the electors declined to endorse the proposal. Both local newspapers supported the proposed grant. Only a small vote was polled and little interest outside of a few active citizens, was taken in the plebiscite. The recent injunction proceedings taken by George E. Harris restraining an exhibition association from issuing debt, probably had some effect upon the result. An official of the exhibition association says the election will be held in 1909 notwithstanding today's vote. Searching for Runaway Boy. C. H. Beardsley, of Berwick (N. S.), is in the city searching for his fifteen year old son, who ran away from home two months ago because he did not want to go to school. The lad left home with \$18 in his pocket. He first went to Fredericton, then to St. John, later working in Robb's Foundry, Amherst, and in the Minto Hotel here, and was there a couple of weeks ago. The lad's mother is seriously ill and she is anxious to find him. It is believed the young runaway has left for other parts as the police can get no tidings of him. Charles F. Payne, of the I. C. "STAND PATTERS" AGAINST AMERICAN-GERMAN TRADE TREATY

New York, N. Y., July 25.—A declaration that the tariff treaty agreement between the United States and Germany recently promulgated by President Roosevelt is contrary to law and the policy of protection, was adopted by the board of managers and executive committee of the American Protective Tariff League at a meeting in this city yesterday. A resolution asserting, well known to the cabinet and members of Congress. It declares that although the customs administrative act provides that all ad valorem duties shall be assessed at the retail market value in the principal markets of the country from which the goods are exported, this agreement construes the market value to be the price of production wherever the merchandise is sold wholly for export.
