

GALLAGHER, CHARLES. (*Kootenay*.)

B. in Ireland. Ed. there. Unmarried. Came to B.C. 1862. First returned to Legislature for present seat at g.e. 1875; re-elected at last g.e.—*Kootenay*.

HARRIS, W. (*New Westminster*.)

First returned to Legislature at last g.e.—*Maple Ridge*.

HELGESON, H. (*Esquimalt*.)

First returned to Legislature at last g.e. A Conservative.—*Metchosen*.

HUMPHREYS, Hon. THOMAS BASIL. (*Victoria District*.)

B. at Liverpool, England, 1840. Ed. at Walton. M., Nov. 1873, Miss Carrie Watkins. Sat in the B.C. Legislature before the Union with Canada. Apptd. a mem. of the Ex. Council, and Minister of Finance and Agriculture, 1 Feb. 1876. Resigned portfolio in July 1876. Apptd. Provincial Secretary on resignation of Elliott Administration, 1878. (*Salary*, \$3,500) Sat for Lillooet from g.e. 1871 until g.e. 1875, when returned for present seat; re-elected by acclamation on his appt. to office. Again returned for present seat at last g.e. A Conservative.—*Victoria*.

MCGILLIVRAY, DONALD, J.P. (*New Westminster*.)

S. of John McGillivray, formerly of the Township of Lochiel, Co. Glengarry, Ont. B. 2 Dec. 1838. Ed. in the common schools. M. in B.C., 8 May 1868, Susan Hall. First returned to Legislature at last g.e.—*Sumas*.

MCILMOYL, JAMES THOMAS, J.P. (*Victoria*.)

B., 1840, in Ontario. Ed. there. M., Jan. 1870, in Saanich, B.C., Miss Simpson. First returned to Legislature at last g.e. A Liberal Conservative, and in favor of immediate railway construction or separation.—*North Saanich*.
