ponytailed leaps from the garage roof saddle shoes skip in agate paved pussy willow-whiskered lanes


rag-tag games of kick-the-can and knock-out ginger as pheasants fly on corner lots and garter snakes slide for cover

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
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Here are the weekly winners of the "Spot the Buttons" contest.
