

was present. He could not say what time it was when he got the liquor. The Constable did not attempt to show that he was not near the Depot at any specified time; as, being the only Constable in the place and having to make his rounds, he might have gone there at any time.

Judge Dugas took the case in délibéré and on the 21st Ultimo rendered judgment against the Constable and fined him \$50⁰⁰ and costs or one month in jail.
