
Ottawa, September 2, 1913

Rev. Sir,-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 29th ultimo in reference to the examination of children for admission to the Spanish River Industrial School.

In reply I beg to say that if you will refer to the agreement for the maintenance and management of this and similar schools you will find that under clause 2 of Part II of this agreement the Superintendent General covers to provide these schools only with medicines, not with medical attendance. As Dr. Shaw was the regular medical attendant for the Wikwemikong Band his services were available for the school, but conditions are now different and it will be necessary for you to make arrangements for your medical attendance to be paid for from the per capita grant.
