Ottawa, 17th July 1914.

Sir,-

I am in receipt of your letter of the 10th instant relative to the application made by Oliver F.Hill and Effic Hill that a loan of \$500.00 be granted them to enable them to erect a house on their location; and in reply I beg to say that before granting this request the Department desires to receive a guarantee that this loan will be refunded within a period of years. Oliver Hill was granted a loan of \$100.00 and it took him 10 years to repay the same. In view of the fact that the loan is required for the building of a house the Department requires a certificate from the Board of Bealth with regard to the house at present occupied by the Hill family. It should be stated whether it is sanitary or otherwise.
