Ottawa, 11th January, 1915.

Sir:-

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 30th ultimo, with which you forwarded an account from Dr. N. J. Perusse, of Amqui, for professional services rendered to Indians of your agency during the past year, and in reply I re-enclose the account herewith. You should request the doctor to explain why it was necessary for him to give the attendance charged for therein. The Department desires to be informed definitely as to whether there is a doctor resident nearer to the Indians than Dr. Perusse who could have been called upon to attend them. If you consider the doctor's explanation satisfactory, and that the charges for attendance both on the reserve and in his office are fair you may certify the account and re-enclose it to the Department.
