Dear Mr. Henry:

On July 8th, the Prime Minister addressed a private note to Mr. Mackenzie, asking for a report on the application by Harry Lay, Jr., for admission to Royal Military College.

A report has come forward, in the Minister's absence, today, of which I enclose a copy for the Prime Minister's information.

It has not been the policy of the Minister to interfere with the rankings given by the Board of Selection, and in the present case, Mr. Mackenzie will not likely return to Ottawa prior to the opening of the College. If any further representations are to be made in this matter, I think I would have to take them up by telephone with the Minister at Vancouver.
