

in ledge and vein matter and ore. A drift run on the ledge from the deepest part of this cut for 35 feet shows a continuous body of ore all the way. An experimental shipment of ore although taken from a position close to the surface, nevertheless paid more than all the expenses of mining, transportation and treatment. At this point the vein has been uncovered on the surface for about 100 feet, showing a strong well-defined out-crop of good ore and ledge matter. The same vein has been uncovered and proved about 800 feet east of these workings.

On the "Maid of Erin" there has been a working shaft sunk 63 feet, which is in ore all the way to the bottom. The shaft is about five feet by seven and the clear of the ledge is wider. At the bottom of this shaft there is two feet of clean ore. At the 50 foot level in this shaft a drift was run on the vein to the east which shows ore all the way. At one point three feet of clean
