

- (a) to encourage the development of Agriculture and to promote school fairs;
- (b) to raise the standard of homemaking, maintain the national traditions of handicrafts, and to encourage the production and use of Canadian made goods;
- (c) to promote all educational measures, particularly rural education;
- (d) to teach Canadian citizenship and to foster a true spirit of patriotism, to assist in the colonization of new Canadians, and to promote world unity and international understanding;
- (e) to promote the welfare of the child and the health of the public, cooperating to this end with the local authorities and social agencies;
- (f) to disseminate news or information regarding the Women's Institute in order that the objects here referred to may be fittingly attained.
