

After which His Excellency was pleased to make the following Speech to both Houses, viz.

“ *Gentlemen of the Council,*

“ *And Gentlemen of the Assembly,*

“ THE requisite provisions, for the several objects which have been recommended to your consideration, being now in part completed, I shall at present detain you no longer from your private affairs.

“ THE Harmony, which has prevailed in the proceedings of this Session, will be considered as a pledge, and I hope a sure one, of that public prosperity which we are ambitious to promote, and which must always greatly depend on the mutual and sincere co-operation of the several Branches of the Legislature.”

And then the Clerk of the Crown, by His Excellency's command, declared the General Assembly to be prorogued to the SECOND Tuesday in MAY next.
