The Clerk of the Legislative Council delivered, at the Bar of the House, the following Message :—

The Legislative Council have passed the following Bills, with several amendments to each, to which they desire the concurrence of this House :

Bill, intituled, "An Act to amend Chapter forty-five of the Consolidated Statutes of *Canada*, respecting the Inspection of Steamboats, and for the greater safety of Passengers by them."

Bill, intituled, "An Act to extend the powers of the Local Municipality of *Saint Colombe de Sillery*."

And then he withdrew.

The House proceeded to take into consideration the Amendment made by the Legislative Council to the Bill, intituled, "An Act to amend Chapter forty-five of the Consolidated Statutes of *Canada*, respecting the Inspection of Steamboats, and for the greater safety of Passengers by them," and the same was read, as follows :—

Line 10. After "repealed" insert Clause A.

Clause A.—"This Act shall come into force on the first day of January, which will be A. D. 1865."

The said Amendment being read a second time ;

Ordered, That the further consideration of the said Amendment be postponed until to-morrow.

The House proceeded to take into consideration the Amendments made by the Legislative Council, to the Bill, intituled, "An Act to extend the powers of the Local Municipality of *Saint Colombe de Sillery*," and the same were read, as follow :—

Page 1, line 11—After "objects" insert "only."

Page 1, line 16—Leave out "District" and insert "Revenue Divisions."

Page 1, line 18—After "payable" insert "to the said Local Municipality."
