OUR MAIL ARRANGEMENTS

We advise that the mail, via Point St Charles and Summerside, arrived in this city very irregularly, during last week, being upwards of an hour and a half late on at least one evening.

The schedule time for arrival here is ten minutes past eight; but for the week ending Saturday last it was late five days out of the six as will be seen from the following figures: August 18th mail arrived at 8:50; 19th, at 9:10; 21st, at 9:30; 22nd, at 9:00; and 23rd, at 9:45.

It is rather unusual to have the mails late, in midsummer, like this and on enquiry it was ascertained that the delay was caused by the late arrival of the boat at Summerside.

For the past thirty years the Steam Navigation Company have been reaping large profits from their business here; but in all that time they have not made any improvement as regards the carriage of mails and passengers.

It is not only the people of Charlottetown that suffer in account of the lateness of the mails; but it affects the business of the province as a whole.
