Synopsis of Ganadian North-West Land Regulations

Any person who is the sole head of amily, or any male over 18 years gid. may homestead a quarter section o available Dominion land in Manitoba Saskatchewan or Alberta. The appli cant must appear in person at the Dominion Louids Agency or Sub-agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, on certain conditions by father, mother, son daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

Daties-Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of the years. A homesteader may live thin nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by sim or by his father

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter section slongside his homestead. Price \$3.00 per sora

Daties-Must reside upon the home stead or pre-emplion six months in each of six years from date of home-stead entry (including the time required a homestead patent) and cultivate fifty ACTOS OXLINA

A homesteader who has onhis a pre-emption may enter for a purchas-ed homestead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duttes.--Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fify acres and erect a home, worth \$300.00. his homestead right and cannot obtain W. W. COBY


