MARKET A SMALL ONE

Bad Weather Again Responsible for a
Very Poor Attendance—No Grain
Offered.

There was practically no market this morning. The roads are too heavy and the weather too disagreeable for the farmers to venture out, and as a result the market square presented a very restful appearance.

About a dozen loads of hay were offered, and brought very good prices, \$17 was the maximum price paid, and one or two loads went for \$16. There is a very strong demand and the recent bad weather has made it practically impossible to obtain a supply of hay many consumers are entirely out, and the demand next week will likely be very strong and the price will naturally be high.

There was no grain offered, though the demand remains remarkably firm.
