

New York, April 30.—The will of Peter Fenlon Collier, the publisher, filed for probate here yesterday, after making various bequests, provides for the residue of the testator's estate, the total value of which is estimated at from \$4,000,000 to \$5,000,000, shall go to his son, Robert Fenlon Collier, with provision that should his son die without issue, the amount so bequeathed shall go for the maintenance of his orphanage in Monmouth County, New Jersey. An annual income of \$40,000 is provided for the \$500,000 annually is bequeathed to Seton Hall Collier, South Orange, N. J., while St. Joseph's Hospital, Symington, Pa., receives \$10,000. St. Vincent's, Inc., and St. Joseph's Hospital, Cincinnati, Ohio, get \$20,000 each. The residue of the estate is made for the late Mr. Collier's brothers and for several old employees. Robert J. Collier is appointed executor.
