A furvey of Seal and Gillam's islands, which lie 79 deg. 30 min. S. W. of Flamborough-head; distance three miles.

IRST station at a point on the south side of the river close to high-water mark. The S. E. corner of Seal-island bore 26 deg. N. W. Flamborough-head and that corner of Seal-island made an angle of 86 deg. 30 min. distance from first station six surlongs.

Skeond station at S. E. corner of Seal-island. Flamborough-head bore 74 deg. 30. min. N. E. making an angle with first station of 79 deg. From the first station to a creek's mouth west-

From the first station to a creek's mouth west-ward, on the fouth side the angle to second station is So deg.

FROM fecond station betwixt the same creek's mouth and the suff station the angle was 72 deg. 20 min.

THIRD flation at N. E. corner of Scal-island, to a point at the lower end of a bottom of woods, \$6 deg. 30 min. N. E. distance 3 furlongs 7 chains.
