LABOR NOTES AND NEWS FROM ALL QUARTERS.

Interesting Items, Facts and Figures—A Bird's-Eye View of the World of Industry.

CANADA

THE HUNTERS' BOARD OF WORKS greatly exceeded its allowance during the first six months of the year, and quite a number of workmen have been thrown out of work to reduce expenses.

OPERATIONS have been commenced in the construction of the much-talked-of C.P.R. bridge on the Niagara, above the wharves. It is supposed the structure will be finished before the snow flies.

MISSISSAUGA, L. Z. BOURDREAU and J. B. Daboia, with W. Koy and O. Chantel as alternates, have been elected delegates from the Montreal Trades and Labor Council to the Dominion Labor Congress.

AT WINNIPEG, about sixty men who have been working on the "Mony" street sewer contract for Kelly Bros. struck for an increase of wages. They have been getting from \$1.25 to \$1.50 per day, and they now demand \$2.25 a day.

THE CREATION of a new job sheds at Owen Sound in connection with the C.P.R. will be commenced at once. Capt. Cannon's jacking hydraulic pile driver will do the pile driving. The conditions are also being made to the lumber and coal docks.

THE HAMILTON Trades and Labor Council on Friday night, it is reported that the immediate appointment of a trustee should be urged on the Police Commissioners, so that the officer might fulfil his duties and begin his work when the schools re-open. The factory inspector came in for re-annunciation on Saturday. A number of the master plumbers have written for other men to come and fill the vacancies. The men do mind (1) that their day shall consist of nine hours, and (2) that each hour constitute a week's work; (3) that for each hour they rate time at five cents; (4) that they be paid 20 cents per hour and receive the week's wages on Friday afternoon; (5) that the wages for improvers be 20 cents less than the first year, and after that full journeymen's wages. They now work fifty hours a week and receive \$12 wages.

The mining statistics of the last United States census show that during the year 1889, nearly 30 public produced nearly twenty-eight per cent. of the world's product of gold and forty-one per cent of the silver product. The coming year of the gold billion was \$32,897,744, and of the silver \$60,290,385, making a total of almost one hundred millions.

Striker's trouble is reported at Duquesne, Pa., where the employees of the Allegheny Bessemer Steel Co., of Carnegie's Co. are on strike. It is stated 400 steelworkers from McKeesport, Braddock, and other points arrived at Duquesne, and that they will not allow the workmen to enter or leave the mill. Sheriff McHenry is on the ground with a number of deputies. Two men are reported to be seriously injured.

The Superintendent of Immigration at New York reports that 405,064 immigrants arrived at that port during the past fiscal year, as compared with 328,619 during the previous fiscal year. Of last year's arrivals, 74,382 came from Germany, 70,710 from Italy, 35,242 from Ireland, 33,904 from Russia, and the rest from other countries. Nearly 170,000 of the immigrants in question settled in New York State and 60,900 in Pennsylvania; the rest being bound going to Illinois, Michigan and elsewhere.

ONE-THIRD of the immigrants are laborers.
