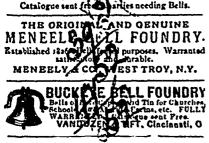

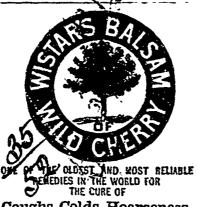

How to Extensitinate Rats.—A writer in the "Scientific American" tells how he clears his premises of rats, and says: "In every crevice where a rat seemed to tread we put the crystal of the copperas, and scattered the same in the corners of the hole. BEEF-TEA FOR INVALIDS.—Miss Dark of the Edinburgh school, recommends the fast lowing as well in the treatment of those who are invalids. She seems so well at le to take care of the healthy that we have some confidence that her recommendations for those who are not may be of value: "Beef taken from the round is best for beef-lea, tecause it is almost free from feet and its those who are not may be of value: "leet taken from the round is best for beef-tea, tecause it is almost free from fat, and it con tains more juice than any other part of the meat. After removing every part of fat, cut the steak into small pieces, across the grain. This breaks the fibre fall allows the juice to escape. Place the healed meat in a discoved sauce-pain, and aweat for five minutes. Sweating is simply beating the meat, not too hot, and stirring it occasionally to prevent its sticking. At the end of five minutes the pan will be found to contain a gravy, or the essence of the meat, which, of itself, is good for very feeble patients. At this stage pour over the meat its weight in solid water, the gauce being a pint of water to each pour dof meat); stir until the water boils and then simmer for five minutes. Do not add salt unless the doctor permits it. In many discases salt cannot be used without doing much haim. Strain the fea while hot, then skim the fat from the surface, and it is ready for use."

Leanness.—Leanness may be caused by insufficient food, or over exertion, or both But the usual cause is disease; the vital powers being more occupied intermoving impurities and poisons, and off coming abnormal conditions, than in digesting and assimilating nutrient material. (In, all fevers, and in all chonic diseases attended with preternatural discharges, as consumption, diarrhea, etc., patients rapidly emariate, while in other forms of chronic diseases, as in scrofula dropsy, and other cachexies, they may become plethoric or co-pulent. Extreme learness is always to be regarded, for all practical purposes, as a condition of indigestion and the remedial plan comprises the whole moner of life. Whater r invigorates the wnole system, or any organ or function, is a remedy for leanness. Food that is simily lattening, as starch, sugar, squps, etc., does not estore the health; although it unduces a temporary appearance of benefit. The patient wants structure instead of afuffing. He wants upper bood, more both, more must and nerve trisue. And these are only derivable from substantial elements. Exercise is important, but is should never be fatiguing. Little and often is the rule for dyspept. Bathing is useful once or twice a week but the temperature of the water should be tenin, or only moderately rool. The patient should avoid exposure to the hot sun, and an places and exercises which occasion swessing.
