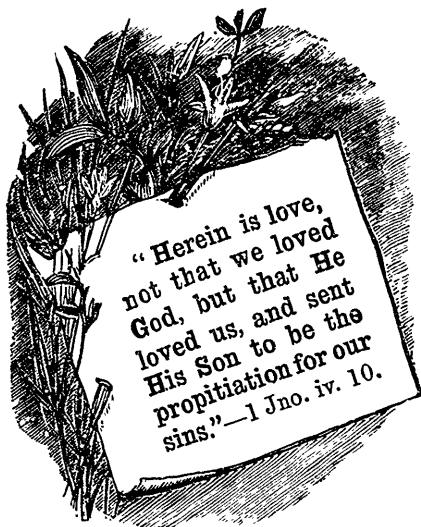

WORKERS’ MEETING.
