AFC Cable (electric wire) and Phillips (semiconductors). The majority of the electronics industry is in subsystem or end item manufacturing.

Companies producing subsystems or multicomponent equipment include: Walco Electric (electric drives and motors), Triangle Wire and Cable (cable and cord sets), Lewiton Manufacturing (electric wiring devices), and Federal Electric (wire harnesses).

End item electronic manufacturers include Federal Products (analog and digital measurement instruments), KVH (heating sensor systems), and Textron (military electronics products).

There are also many companies with electronic component requirements for their end items. These companies include Wardwell Braiding Machine Co., G Tech Corp. (electronic lottery ticket equipment) and John Brown, Inc. (separating machinery for textile and plastics).
