

- (b) exports permits and exit visas, as the case may be, for Canadian personnel and their dependants and for materials, professional and technical equipment and the personal effects of this personnel.

TITLE III: FINAL PROVISIONS

ARTICLE XIII

Any differences which may arise in the application of the provisions of this Agreement, a loan agreement or a specific arrangement, shall be settled by negotiations between the Government of Canada and the Executive Council of the Republic of Zaire or in any other manner mutually acceptable to the Contracting Parties to this Agreement.

ARTICLE XIV

This Agreement shall be effective on the date it is signed by the two Contracting Parties and shall remain effective as long as one Contracting Party or the other has not terminated it by six months' notice in writing. However, such termination shall not void the contracts already entered into and the guarantees already given under this Agreement.
