Guimond, Clerk of the Crown for the District of Montreal, do hereby certify that Fred Rose, the accused in the above case, appeared for his trial, in the City of Montreal, Province of Quebec, before the Court of King's Bench, Crown Side, presided by the Honourable Justice Wilfrid Lazure and an English speaking Jury duly sworn in the present case, on a charge of conspiracy upon The Official Secrets Act, on May 28, 1946; that on June, 15, 1946, the

said Fred Rose was found guilty on the aforesaid charge by the Jury sworn in the case and sentenced on June 20, 1946, by the same Presiding Judge to six years in the penitentiary to be computed and reckoned from this last date.
