An Act to amend *The Railway Act*, 1868, so as to ensure equal facilities to all incorporated Express Companies on Railways heretofore constructed, as well as on those hereafter to be constructed.

TER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Preamble. Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:---

1. Every Railway Company heretofore or which may be here-Railway after incorporated, and whether their Railway has been heretofore Companies to constructed or is hereafter to be constructed, having granted any facilities to facilities to any Express Company, shall grant equal facilities on all Express 5 equal terms and conditions to any other Express Company now incorporated or hereafter to be incorporated in Canada, demanding the same.

2. Sub-section three of section forty-eight of The Railway Act, Repeal. 1868, is hereby repealed.
