

Hon. Mr. CAMPBELL: Does that 30 per cent apply to the United Kingdom?

Mr. McKINNON: That rate applies to all favoured nations.

The CHAIRMAN: Are there any other questions?

Hon. Mr. HAIG: Mr. Chairman, I move that the committee adjourn. I think the discussion we have had here has been most beneficial, and the publicity given to it by the press will do a lot of good.
