

SEVEN FAVORITES FAIL AT WINDSOR

Afterglow, in Sixth Race, Rank Outsider, Is Among the Winners.

R. DAVIES WINS TWO

First Sight in the Frontier Handicap and Also Knights Differ.

WINDSOR, July 16.—A great crowd attended the opening of the first summer meeting here today. There was quite an upset in the Frontier Handicap, that went to Robt. Davies' lightweight First Sight, that has improved steadily since Hamilton, another long shot, was second, and Bushkin, second choice, third. Every favorite was beaten.




