by the contending Parties, fo foon as they are established in power. Indeed, this matter presses with the force of irrefiftible necessity; for at present the fituation of the Public Creditors is altogether deplorable: for if the present Annual Revenue does not exceed Twelve Millions, and there is no grounds or authority to state it at any thing that fignifies more; and if the Annual Demand for the Debt Funded and Unfunded. and foreseen with certainty, shall amount to Ten Millions yearly (and from what I have substantiated, it cannot amount to materially less); and if the Civil List and current Peace-Establishment are nearly as I have stated them (and I apprehend the probability is, that they, particularly the last, will rather amount to more than less than I have estimated them at); these matters being so, the Public Account will stand as follows:
