such appeal will be presented. shall be entitled to have his case heard before the members of the Association at any regular or special meeting thereof, and the decision on the appeal by three-fourths of the members present, constituting a quorum, shall be final and be observed by the Trustees aforesaid.

SECTION 2. In case of the death of a member in good standing, caused by the performance of his duty as a fireman, or otherwise, the surviving members shall be assessed the sum of one dollar each, and said sum so assessed, together with the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, to be drawn by the Trustees from the funds of the Association, shall be paid by the Association to the family or relatives of the deceased.

SECTION 3. The Board of Trustees may give orders on the Treasurer for benefits due while the assessment is being collected; provided that the funds in the hands of the Treasurer will warrant the same.

ARTICLE XI.

The Chairman of the Board of Trustees, upon receipt of notice from any Trustee stating that any member of his company has been injured or disabled by sickness caused by performance of his duty as a fireman, or otherwise, as expressed in Article IX, shall investigate as to the cause and nature of said injury or sickness. and. in connection with the other Trustees, have general supervision of said case. and at any regular or special meeting of the Association report the facts of the case.
