RULES FOR THE SECOND CONTINGENT FOR AFRICA

Official Statement Showing the Recruiting Localities and the Places for Concentration of the Chosen Men.

Three Squadrons of Mounted Men and Three Batteries of Artillery Will Be Put in Shape at the Earliest Possible Moment—The Qualifications Required and Place of Assembly.

Ottawa, Dec. 21.—Militia orders issued tonight give the details of the second contingent to South Africa.

The Canadian Regiment of Mounted Rifles will have one lieutenant-colonel in command, a second in command, an adjutant, transport officer, quartermaster and medical officer.

Officers commanding will pay all expenses out of the imprest sent them. Permission has been given for the commissioner to be good enough to arrange for the troops alloted to the Northwest Mounted Police being provided with horses.

The organization of the brigade division of artillery will be as follows: There will be three batteries, C, D, and E, Royal Canadian Artillery. C will be mobilized at Kingston, D at Ottawa and E at Quebec.

There will be a lieutenant-colonel commanding, adjutant, medical officer, veterinary officers, a total brigade division staff of 17, with 16 horses.

Men will be enrolled for the units alloted, according to the distribution contained in the schedules issued through the brigades.
