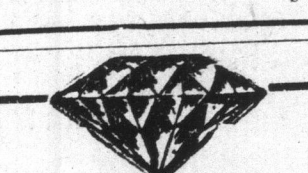

LABOR MEN WILL ASK FOR CARS TO SPRINGBANK SUNDAY

Petitions Will Be Circulated in City Factories Shortly.

HELP TO MINISTERS CLAIM

Special Meetings at the Park Could Reach Non-Churchgoers, Is Said.

At a meeting of the Trades and Labor Council last evening a resolution was passed approving of Sunday car service. Petitions will be issued by the labor men and will be circulated in the offices and factories of the city.

The following committee was chosen to issue the petitions and look after the matter of Sunday car service: Springbank, DeLates, Hessel, Scott, Fountain, Howarth, Vining, McArthur, and Avey.

TRAIN SOLDIERS AS WATCHMAKERS, JEWELERS' ADVICE

Resolution Will Be Sent to the Department of Education.

TARIFF ILL-CONSIDERED

Government Regulations Are Scored at Retail Men's District Convention.

A resolution urging the department of education and those in charge of the various vocational training schools for returned soldiers to adopt a course of instruction in watchmaking and jewelry was unanimously passed at the second annual convention of the Western Ontario Retail Jewellers' Association, held in London, Wednesday afternoon. This action was taken on the recommendation of Thomas Roden, of Toronto, at the close of his address on the question of securing future markets for soldiers in the jewelry trade.

Mr. Roden, after graphically picturing the period of his own apprenticeship for soldiers in the jewelry trade, for the first six months of their work with no remuneration in order to learn the trade, drew attention to the changed conditions.

"The condition is very different in these days. New standards have been set up, and the situation is very difficult. Unless the dignity of the mechanic's calling is recognized in Canada, the country will eventually become the property of foreigners, who realize the needs of the manufacturers as regards capable help."

The parents are at fault, as well as the boys, for the existing conditions. The speaker, boys are encouraged to enter the professions rather than learn the jewelry trade. Girls cannot take the boys' places in mechanical work, as they are not settled enough. They cannot be beaten in financial institutions and similar places, however. The two methods of mechanics outlined are the encouragement of technical schools and vocational schools for mechanics. The speaker said that the future of the jewelry trade will be in the hands of the boys. To encourage the boys to enter the jewelry trade, the speaker suggested that the government should offer scholarships to boys who enter the jewelry trade. Dwelling on the value of industrial porcelaine, he emphasized the need for scientific research to his end, and urged his hearers to give all possible aid to the tariff.

The tariff was touched upon lightly by Mr. Roden, being upheld by him as necessary for the proper equalization of living conditions.

Mr. Nelson of St. Thomas gave, for the benefit of the members, his experience with the new price list.

Mr. Nelson said that he had been in the jewelry trade for many years, and that he had seen the industry go through many changes. He said that the industry was now in a very difficult position, and that it was necessary for the government to take action to help it.

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Jewelers and their guests adjourned to Springbank Park, where they were guests of the London Jewellers' Club. The first sporting event was the baseball game, London Jewellers vs. the side-jewellers. The latter won, 18 to 13, despite the stunts dished up by J. A. Nash for the Londoners, and the work of A. A. Collinson behind the bat. Boxing in barrels provided amusement to all visitors.
