COULD AVOID ACCIDENTS.

Factory Inspectors Say There Are Too No Law Against Unemployed From Many Fatalities. U. S. Coming Here.

The department of agriculture has issued an appendix to the annual report of the inspector of factories. dealing with accidents. The report says that records of accidents in European countries, as well as in can be done to restrain the influx, as only the physically and mentally unfit cat be prevented from entering can-Canada, show beyond reasonable dcubt, that a great portion of accidents are avoidable.

There were 638 industrial accidents in Ontario reported to the inspectors in 1904, 633 in 1905, and 636 in 1906.
