NOVEMBER.

This month will set in with unusually fine weather, which will last until the 6th, when storms of rain and wind will prevail with only occasional intervals until the 14th, when it will clear up into clear frosty weather. On the 20th a considerable fall of snow, followed by changeable, rainy and disagreeable weather until the 28th, when a severe frost will set in.

PROTECTION OF GRAIN AGAINST MICE AND OTHER VER-MIN.—Put at the bottom, near the centre and the top of each stack, as it is raised, three or four stalks of wild mint, with the leaves on. The same experiment may be tried with cheeses, and with equal effect, by laying a few leaves green or dry, on the articles to be preserved.
