THIRD NOVA SCOTIA CONFERENCE

The third session of the Nova Scotia Annual Conference the Methodist Church of Canada, began at Windsor, on Wednesday, June 21st, 1876.

The Rev. A. W. Nicolson, President of the Conference, took the chair at 9 o'clock, a. m.
