PURCHASE PRICE OF SHEDIAC PLANT Action Taken by Electric Light and Power Co. in Sales Move DEURCHASE PRICE UPON ST. JOHN RIVER VAN BUREN, Me., March 26.— There is no sign yet of the Saint John River going on a rampage this spring. The river is at a low pitch and the ice appears as hard and solid as at any time this winter and some ice is being cut and stored. While the snow is reported as melting fast in the upper valley and on the head waters the effects have not been felt yet by the main river. The snowfall is reported about the average in depth in the woods but light and of comparatively small water content. Indications are that the ice will be much later than usual in leaving the river unless there are unusual conditions.






