IN PARLIAMENT

Strawberry Boxes Must be Long Quart Size.

Ottawa, May 31.—(Canadian Press)—Yesterday in the House of Commons the special committee on proportional representation presented a report recommending that before action is taken, a plebiscite should be held. The report of the special committee on fuel, railways and canals, and public accounts was tabled.

Hon. Mr. Tolmie, minister of agriculture, refused to consider a petition to permit the use of "short" or three quart long quart strawberry boxes this year. The long quart box will have to be used.

A. Stein, Kamouraska, moved to send the de Marigny divorce bill back to the committee on private bills for further hearing of evidence. This was defeated 46 to 58.

Subsequent debate in committee was "held over" until today on motion of J. J. Denis, (Joliette).

A bill amending the dominion land act and a bill amending the northwest territories act were given third reading.

The House took up the loan of \$80,000,000 to the Grand Trunk. F. H. Cahill of Pontiac, moved to reduce the amount by \$22,000,000. This motion was lost. On suggestion of A. B. Copp of Westmorland, the item was allowed to stand over until the next sitting of the House.

The civil government vote for the department of labor was carried. Supplementary estimates were tabled. The House adjourned at 1:05 a. m.

In the Senate the copyright bill was given second reading. A compromise was reached on the judges act amendments as the result of conference between senate and commons committees.

SUMMARIZES PREMIER'S VIEW IN COAL CRISIS

London, May 31.—(By Canadian Press)—Following is a summary of Lloyd George's attitude on the coal strike as prepared by a London newspaper writer and based upon the British prime minister's recent speeches on the strike situation.

The first thing is to get rid of the notion that there are huge profits in the mines and that the grasping capitalists are trying to rob the miners of their share.

The mines are not paying because prices tumbled down suddenly. If the price of home coal were increased the cost of every article would go up.

There is no conspiracy to reduce wages, and the taxpayers cannot be asked to contribute to keep up the wages of one industry.

Government control has done more to destroy the case for nationalization than a million speeches could have done. The principle of "the national pool" is a premium on inefficiency. It would mean a gigantic army of inspectors.

If we surrender to threats and starvation and make an imprudent peace, we may be irretrievably engaging the industry of the country.

GIRL BRIDE AT 15 ACCUSED OF BIGAMY

Warrant Charges She Had a Husband When She Again Became a Wife on April 2.

New York, May 31.—Although only fifteen years old, Florence Cobleigh, of 61 Moore Street, Brooklyn, was a prisoner in the Children's Court in that Borough last week charged with having two husbands. On account of her youth the complaint against her was technically described as juvenile delinquency.

Justice Wilkin remanded the girl to the care of the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Children until June 2, when he will hold a hearing in her case.

The girl was arrested by Detective William Kenna of the Adams Street station on a warrant secured by Otto Berringer, 23, an ironworker of 1117 110th Street, Richmond Hill. Berringer said he married the girl on April 2. His bride left him two weeks later. He was informed that she had a husband when she married him. He investigated and found that on Nov. 24, 1920, his wife was married to Robert Brockhurst, 19, of 683 Gates Avenue. After his discovery Berringer caused the girl's arrest.

Berringer told Detective Kenna that when he went to the Marriage License Bureau to get his license to wed the girl showed him a birth certificate which indicated that she was eighteen years old. He found afterwards that the certificate had been altered. He also said that after he found out about the first marriage an annulment, that she had lived only a few days with Brockhurst and that both he and she had decided that they were not suited to each other and decided to separate.
