

MARITIME MEET HERE NEXT YEAR

St. John Men Elected Officers of
Maritime Provinces Golf Association
at Truro Meeting

Truro, July 17.—The third day of the maritime golf meet witnessed the playing of the semi-finals for the championship and the first, second and third consolation. The weather was misty in the morning but warm and sunny in the afternoon. In the championship semi-finals J. M. Murphy, of Halifax, won from G. A. Evans, of Halifax, six up and five to go and B. S. McFarlane, of Truro, won from W. A. Henry, of Halifax, one up.

The game between McFarlane and Henry was the feature of the day. McFarlane made the nine holes in 88 getting par at every hole except one. In a friendly match on Monday McFarlane went round the course in 87 with a six number two.

SIR E. CARSON EXPLAINS SPEECH

London, July 17.—(Canadian Associated Press)—Sir Edward Carson, the Ulster leader, today gave his reasons for his speech at Belfast last Saturday, the subject of which was debated in the House of Commons yesterday.

"Consider this De Valera campaign in America which is being conducted against the integrity of the British Empire by people who were our enemies all through the war," he said. "It is being utilized, both on the other side of the Atlantic and on this with the obvious aim of broadening Ulster and forcing her under some sort of Dublin parliament. Now remember that throughout the war Ulster men and women were the foremost of the king's subjects in devoting themselves and their substance to the support of the empire and to fight the fight for liberty and justice. I know well how bitterly they feel at the suggestion that their reward should be handed over to their enemies and I spoke as I did in order to let it be clearly known that Ulster will not stand it."

ELECTIONS IN P. E. I. NEXT WEEK

The election of a new legislature in Prince Edward Island will take place next week. Mr. Arsenault, the leader of the government, in presenting his case, says that in eight years since the Liberal-Conservative party came into power, the public debt has been reduced by something more than \$10,000, that 2,500 feet of steel bridges have been constructed, and \$200,000 expended in permanent public works; that an average of \$45,000 per year more than was paid by his predecessors, has been paid out of the treasury for education, that supplements to the salaries are now given by the government that the supplements voted by the school districts have increased from \$23,792 in 1911 to \$48,630 in 1918; that this year again a further large increase has been made; and that the present government has already been the means of spreading between fifty and sixty thousand tons of muskeg mud on the lands of the province. Casting a look towards Ottawa, he adds: "Liberal-Conservatives succeeded in getting an additional subsidy of \$100,000 per year. Not only did they unlock the door, but they took the money merely on account, and left the door open so that now these claims are in a better position than they were previous to 1912 by reason that, having been recognized and part payment made on account they cannot now be repudiated."
