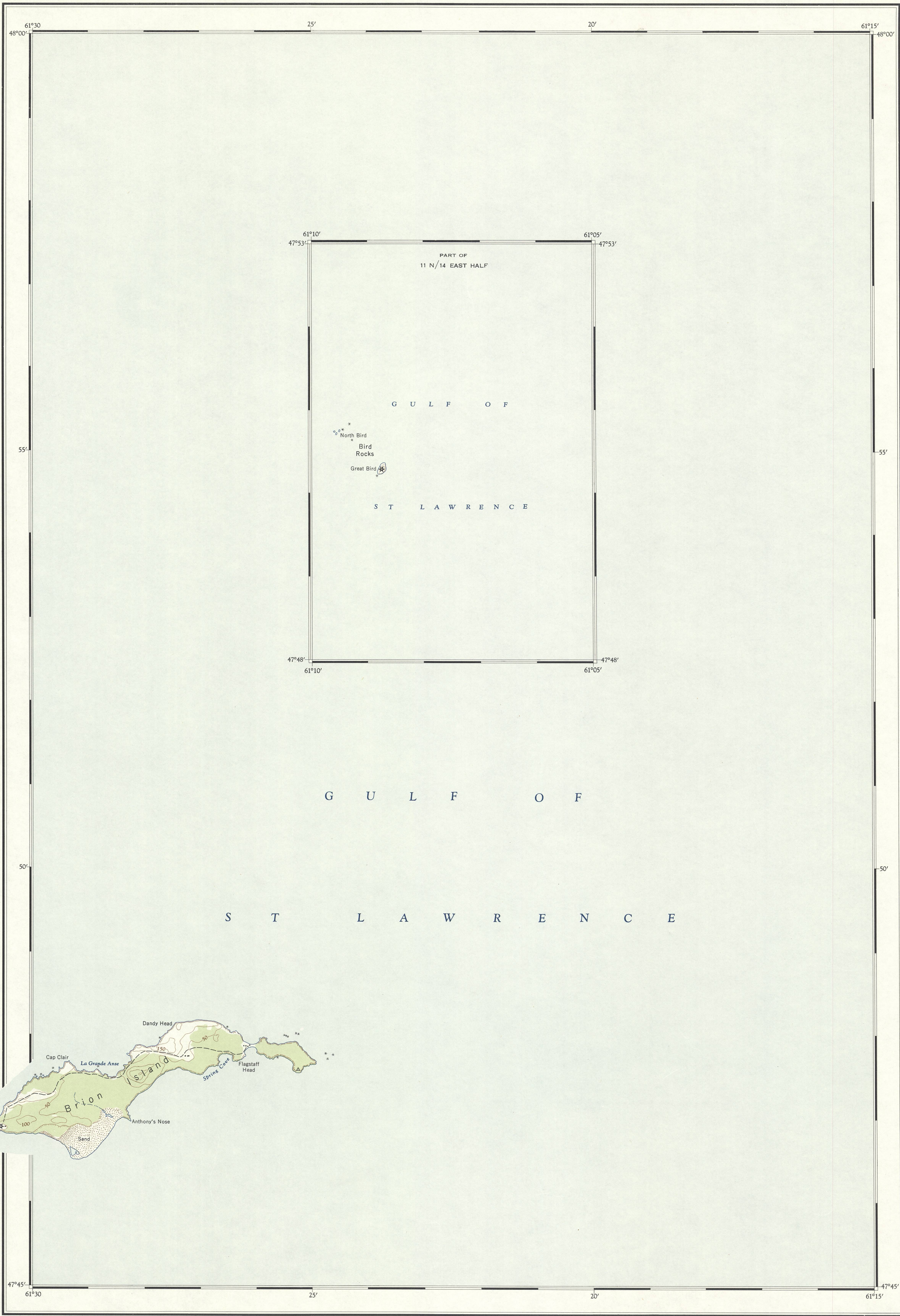




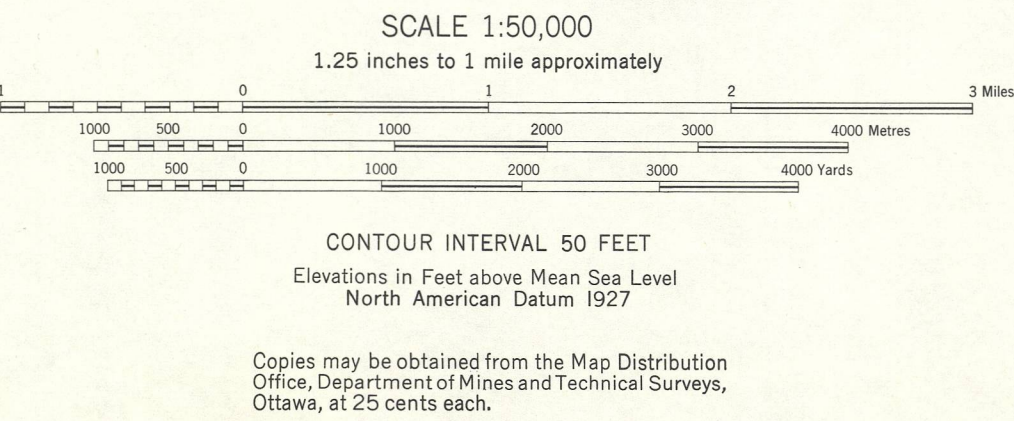

Annual magnetic change 2' 30" easterly

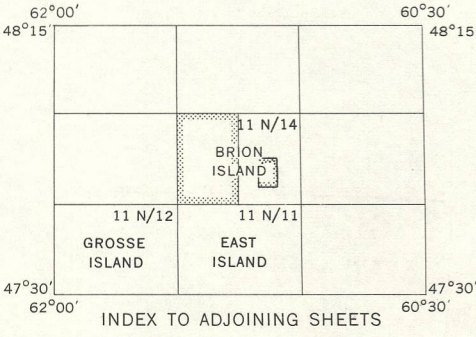
