GRAND TRUNK PACIFIC DEBATE.

OTTAWA, Sept. 2.—The Grand Trunk Pacific bill was up in committee today, but the opposition prevented much progress, although the preamble was adopted. A long discussion was indulged in on the wisdom of the government's claim that they were thoroughly familiar with the route to be followed. Laurier was challenged to produce any modern survey.

Mr. Ingram pointedly told the premier that he had been used as a political tool by his political friends.

Mr. Monk suggested that the debate should be adjourned until the government was prepared to bring down more information, but Sir Wilfrid Laurier would only consent to this with an understanding that the bill would be speedily adopted when next considered.

The opposition declined to make any such promise.

Owing to the late sitting this morning, the house adjourned.

THE EMPIRE BUILDERS.

Twelve years ago Cecil Rhodes wrote a letter to Sir John A. McDonald, forecasting practically the same imperial scheme that Chamberlain advances today. This letter, only recently published, brings to the affirmative side of the discussion now agitating England the approval of the greatest Englishman of the last generation, a man whose every thought was for the empire and whose every work was directed towards making his thoughts realities. While he was widening the extent of British dominion he was also planning for its consolidation. He saw the need of something more tangible than sentiment to hold so vast an empire always together. But among the statesmen of his day were few big enough to grasp his ideas and, looking for support, he finds, away across in Canada, a kindred spirit, one whose spoken and acted policy had tended in the same direction as his own.

So one empire builder writes to the other.

"The whole thing lies in the question," says Rhodes, "can we invent home ties with the mother country that will prevent separation. There must be a practical solution, which will be of benefit to generations yet unborn. England's course lies in England's politicians, who cannot see into the future, and who think that England will always be the manufacturing centre of the world, but do not understand what a system of protection, coupled with reciprocal relations among the different parts of the empire means."

There's the scheme, shadowy and undeveloped, but the same scheme that Chamberlain is trying to work out today.

If two such men as Rhodes and Sir John had got back of it twelve years ago with their joint force and foresight, how much easier would be the task before Chamberlain now.

But Sir John never saw the letter. It was dated May 8, 1891. Sir John died on June 6, before it could have reached Canada. In the letter Rhodes expressed a wish that they two might meet before storm fate claimed them. The world rolls along very well when those who while they live seem indispensable, go away. But when one looks at the men who have taken the places of these two, it must be with the wish that Fate had held his hand a little while longer.
