FORESIGHT LACKING IN LIEGE ATTACK

New York, Aug. 8.—Reports that Liege, the greatest commercial city in Belgium, was in flames, in places, as the result of German shell-fire, created dismay and rage among the hundreds of Belgian volunteers who have flocked here from all parts of the country on their way to Europe.

"It is monstrous and inhuman the sight being made into the city of Liege. It lies on right bank of the Meuse River, in the centre of the circle of twelve forts, which comprise the fortifications of the district of Liege. It is flatter than New York, and its approaches inside the forts are unguarded.
