**SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH
WEST LAND REGULATIONS**

The sole head of a family, or any
over 18 years old, may homestead a
ter-section of available Dominion la
Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta.
plicant must appear in person at the

Duties—Six months residence upon cultivation of the land in each of years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a tract of at least 80 acres, on certain

Duties—Six months residence in one of three years after earning home

A settler who has exhausted his
stead right may take a purchased
stead in certain districts. Price \$3.
acre. Duties—Must reside six months
each of three years, cultivate 50
and erect a house worth \$200.

The area of cultivation is subject to reduction in case of rough, scrubby land. Live stock may be subordinated for cultivation under certain conditions.
